How to secure quality of education in Katedralskolen? (13:17)

Arash. Focus on education adapted to the students' needs (tilpasset opplæring) with dynamic evaluations, anchored in well documented methods. Parents seen as resources. Hilde informed. Kunnskapsløftet ("Lift of knowledge") launched in 2006. Each teacher has the right and responsibility for adapted education. Evaluation system and the professionals involved. Question: Can adapted education be improved?

Are there differences in marking among teachers at Katedralskolen and other schools?

Headmaster showed thorough statistics from final assessment (standpunkt) to exam marks in Sør-Trøndelag and Norway. The documentation supports the idea that Kattas teachers are not stricter than elsewhere.
